




'What are you doing with those plastic bottles, Clunk?' Ben asks. 'Where are you taking them?'

'Let's go,' says Grandpa. Clunk starts the van.


When the van stops it's in a new place, with lots of big machines and trucks.

'Please can we see the machines?' he asks. 'OK,' says Kim.








Then Kim takes them to the machine for plastic bottles. A truck is putting bottles on a big belt.

Grandpa and Kim go with Rosie.





When Clunk learns about the key, he has an idea, too. He runs to the van. He pushes a red button and then ...

Clunk jumps out of the van again. 'And I'm small, too! Now I can find your key, Max!'






Oh no! The belt is moving again.







Then Ben and Max hear a truck behind them. Kim is driving it.
