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



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Clunk doesn't sit down. He goes to the van.

The children have a nice picnic.


'That was great! Thank you, Grandpa,' says Rosie. 'But it's four o'clock. Where's Clunk?'


'I don't know,' says Grandpa.

Grandpa ties the wire to his umbrella. Then he points to a big rock.

Clunk goes to the rock with the umbrella and Grandpa goes to the van.


'What are they doing?' asks Max.

But Clunk doesn't answer.


'Is he OK?' asks Rosie.
