






Tim wins this race, too. Again, he isn't tired.


'Well done, Tim!' shouts his dad.

'I don't want to win any more races today,' says Tim.


'There's one more race,' says his dad. 'You can stop after you win that.'

Ben runs to the door, but he is too slow. Tim jumps in front of him.


'Where are you going?' Tim asks.

'Maybe you're right,' Tim says. 'But my dad gets angry when I don't win.'




'I'm sorry,' says Tim from behind the door. 'I can open the door after I win the big race.'

Ben is running fast and he does not see her.


'Ben!' shouts Rosie. 'Stop!'
