Grandpa smiles and says, 'It's hot here, but I'm going to a very cold place ...'






'Let's go, Clunk!' says Grandpa.


'We're in the Arctic!' says Grandpa.



The two cubs stop their game. They look up and see the children.


'They're scared of us,' says Ben.

But one of the cubs runs.









There is a new sound from the ice, and the cub stops.

'Oh no!' says Grandpa. 'The ice is too thin there. The cub can't walk on it!' There are cracks in the ice under the cub's feet.







A big polar bear is running on the ice.

'The mother wants to protect her cubs!'






The mother bear goes to the thin ice.


'It's too thin for a big bear!' says Rosie.


But the mother bear lies down on the ice. Then she crawls to the scared cub.


'Polar bears can't walk on thin ice, but they can crawl,' says Grandpa.





'Look!' says Ben. 'The cub is learning from his mother. That's fantastic!' Soon the cub is on thick ice.


